WHERE DO I FIT IN AS A MEMBER?

You belong to a Women's Auxiliary Branch in your own Church. Your Branch has a President and Executive Committee.

THE STRUCTURE OF THE AUXILIARY

Your Branch is affiliated to the District which is part of the Connexional (National) body of the Auxiliary.

Several Circuits form a DISTRICT which has a District President and Executive.

District Meetings are held annually. Each branch sends representatives to District Meetings each year.

9 out of 13 Districts form part of a National Organisation within the Methodist Church.

The National Body is called the GENERAL EXECUTIVE (GENEX) headed by the General President and Executive.

The Annual Meetings are called CONNEXIAL MEETINGS.

The business oversees the work of women into the Methodist Church of Southern Africa.
